Agreement for students participating in the Aquinas Sports Academy

By accepting a position in the Aquinas Sports Academy, I agree to the following:

ASA SELECTION CRITERIA

Candidates will be ranked on the application criteria which will consider the students ability to:

- Manage their academic and sporting commitments;
- Exhibit a high degree of ability within a given sport;
- Represent in at least one sport at the provincial level or hold a national ranking;
- Demonstrate commitment to training, excellence, and reaching their potential within a given sport – desire to become an elite athlete;
- Potential to be socially compatible and display a sense of ‘team ethic’ in a learning environment;
- Perform and develop within the ASA program previously (if a previous participant);
- Incorporate the touchstone values into everyday life at Aquinas.

Applications received will be short-listed by the Director of Sport;

The final decision regarding the ASA participants for the following year will be made by a panel comprising:

- Director of Sport;
- School Principal.

All applicants whether successful or other will be notified by the Director of Sport.

Please also note that a fee will be charged for students involved in the program. This will be indicated at the start of the year when program content is finalized.
